The Kiwanis Club of Walnut Valley, California was organized and chartered on November 26, 1963. The official dedication of the Club was on January 28, 1964. We meet every Friday morning at the Holiday Inn Select in Diamond Bar, 21725 Gateway Center Drive. Our meetings start at 7:00 AM and end at 8:00 AM.

Our Club is considered small to medium-sized, and represents many segments in our community. This size allows us to become closer friends than a larger club. Club bylaws state that members attend at least two meetings per month and make up missed meetings by attending the meeting of another club, a Board meeting, or any Kiwanis event.
