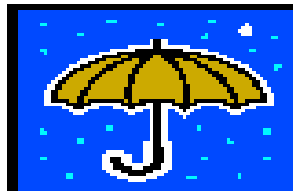
Ted stood to announce that Mary Su, mayor of Walnut, will be our speaker on August 28 and he received another “Wonderful Job” from President Richard.
