Faith Mellinger and Robin DeKleine spoke to us concerning Habitat for Humanity – turns out that Faith had groupies in the Hacienda Heights club! Although President Jimmy Carter is a very active volunteer with the group, he was not the founder, contrary to popular opinion. Linda and Millard Fuller originated the group and President Carter joined about six years later. Information will be forthcoming on efforts to benefit Haiti. The group have built 41 homes locally – No. 40 in Chino Hills and No. 41 in Glendora – since 1991. In 2007 they initiated a “Brush with Kindness” program, assisting low income, elderly, and disabled residents in need of external housekeeping for painting and fencing. Donations to the group are down quite a bit and they encourage us to visit Restore, their fundraising project on Holt Boulevard in Montclair. This is a building materials surplus store where you can purchase unused housing items (or gently used!) at significant savings. Following the presentation, a winning opportunity was selected for Lon Salgren of Hacienda Heights, but the Joker stayed with us. *** Hail, Kiwanis!
