There was a very large audience at the AQMD and a vote was postponed until next Tuesday at 6:30 p.m. at the District office. Don did see Mr. Cross and Mr. Layton and reports they are both in good health!

Kathleen Newe was out of town today and Rae Duncan visited us to update us on activities at the Friends of the Diamond Bar Library. Rae has been with the group for 25 years and states that this is the best group with which she has ever been involved. The goals of the group are to increase literacy and the love of reading. They sponsor Read Together Diamond Bar, Festival of Authors, the annual Wine Soiree (in its 17<sup>th</sup> year), Basically Books (the only book store in Diamond Bar), and the children's Spelling Bee among other activities. The Third Annual Spelling Bee will be held on February 27 at Mt. SAC. The Friends consist of 160 members with 14 Board Members. Annual dues are \$5.00 for Seniors; \$10.00, Individual; \$20.00, family; \$100.00, Corporate; and \$150.00 for a Lifetime membership.

Our own Rich Malooly will again be the Master of Ceremonies for the Soiree to be held at the Diamond Bar Center on Sunday, April 11, from 4:00-7:00 p.m. Tickets are \$50.00 per person, going to \$60.00 at the door. Proceeds will benefit efforts such as repairing worn books, adding books, and increasing the foreign collection at the library.

The library includes a children's area and a program known as A Family Place for children from birth to three years of age. Jesse Lanz is the Acting Community Library Manager. He has been there about a month and Rae describes him as "young and enthusiastic". He plans to continue the great programs already in place and incorporate ever-expanding technology. The goal of the Friends for 2010 is improving the Community Room.

Basically Books moved again to its new location at 23447 Golden Springs Drive, the junction of Golden Springs and Diamond Bar Boulevard. The store had a soft opening last week with a Grand Opening scheduled for March 6 at 10:00 a.m. and a ribbon cutting ceremony with the Chamber of Commerce at noon on March 16. 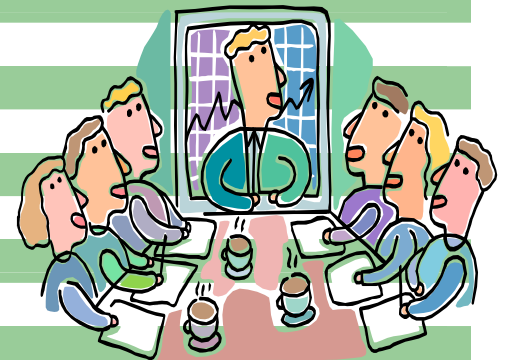
